Other Corridor Characteristics

- This corridor serves as a major connector to the Americas International Bridge for the eastbound traffic.
- Currently under construction is the <u>I-10 Connect</u> <u>Project</u>, which primary goal is to increase mobility and reduce congestion leading to Port of Entry through the construction and modification of direct connectors between I-10 and both US-54 and I-110.
- It is also part of the <u>Downtown 10 Project</u> from TxDOT which plans to improve mobility and long-term congestion management
