The Far West Texas/El Paso Regional Transportation Coordination Coalition (WTEP) encompasses the Texas counties of Brewster, Culberson, El Paso, Hudspeth, Jeff Davis and Presidio Counties, with nearly 826,000 citizens and 21,700 square miles. WTEP formed under the direction of the Texas Department of Transportation as required by the Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 461 – Statewide Coordination of Public Transportation, June 2005. The code’s amendment established a requirement for “Statewide Coordination of Public Transportation” with three expressed goals: Eliminate waste in the provision of public transportation services; Generate efficiencies that will permit increased levels of service; and Further the state’s efforts to reduce air pollution. To achieve these goals, the Texas Department of Transportation established a Regional Service Planning project within the Public Transportation Division and required that each of the 24 planning regions in the state submit a Regional Transportation Coordination Plan.
