



**7 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR NOVEMBER 18, 2022  
EL PASO MPO TPB MEETING**

Public comments for amendments to the El Paso MPO's documents are being accepted. The MPO's Transportation Policy Board (TPB) will consider these projects for approval at their November 18, 2022 meeting.

- [Consider amendments to the Regional Mobility Strategy \(RMS\) 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan \(MTP\), Amended Destino 2045 MTP, Destino 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program \(TIP\), and RMS 2023-2026 TIP to program the Border Highway Connector \(BHC\) Preliminary Engineering Phase project in Fiscal Year \(FY\) 2024](#)

If approved, this project will allow NMDOT to develop the project location and corridor alignment study for the Border Highway Connector project. This project is anticipated to be submitted in the New Mexico December 2022 STIP Amendment.

- [Consider amendments to the RMS 2050 MTP to deprogram the Zaragoza POE Pedestrian Drop Off and Pick Up Areas project in FY 2029 and the Zaragoza POE Pedestrian Shade Canopies in FY 2031](#)

The deprogramming of these projects will ensure there is no duplication of scope with the *Ysleta Port of Entry Pedestrian and Site Improvements* project funded with USDOT RAISE Grant funds. This amendment does not require a STIP revision and will be completed upon approval of the RMS 2050 MTP.

- [Consider amendments to the RMS 2050 MTP and RMS 2023-2026 TIP to change project limits for the Montana RTS 1st year Operating Assistance project in FY 2023 and Montana RTS 2nd year Operating Assistance project in FY 2024](#)

This amendment will ensure there is consistency with the project limits across all three Operating assistance years for the Montana RTS project. If approved, this amendment is anticipated to be submitted in the Texas February 2023 STIP Revision

- Consider amendments to the RMS 2050 MTP and RMS 2023-2026 TIP to program the Feasibility Study and Alternatives Analysis for Regional Fare Structure and Payment System project using FY 2020 Helping Obtain Prosperity for Everyone (HOPE) Grant funds in Fiscal Year (FY) 2023

The City of El Paso has been awarded HOPE Grant funds for a feasibility assessment and alternatives analysis for a unified regional fare structure and payment system to best meet the needs of the region and enhance mobility for people in low-income areas. If approved, this project will be submitted in the next available STIP Revision.
