The Transportation Policy Board (TPB) approved the following amendments to the 2045 Destino Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and the Destino 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) at its October 19, 2018 meeting.

# **Highway Projects:**

- Program the Lisa Drive Connectivity Project (LDCP) Preliminary Engineering Phase (Dona Ana County) (MPO ID#E603A/CN E100290) to continue the multi-purpose path and environmental control feature which provides increased ADA accessibility adjacent to Lisa Drive using \$42.619 of New Mexico TAP funds in FY 2020.
- 2. Program the Lisa Drive Connectivity Project (LDCP) Construction Phase I (Dona Ana County) (MPO ID# E603B/CN E100290) to continue the multi-purpose path and environmental control feature which provides increased ADA accessibility adjacent to Lisa Drive using \$42,619 of New Mexico TAP funds in FY 2021.
- Program the Lisa Drive Connectivity Project (LDCP) Construction Phase II (Dona Ana County) (MPO ID# E603C/CN E100290) to continue the multi-purpose path and environmental control feature which provides increased ADA accessibility adjacent to Lisa Drive using \$42,619 of New Mexico TAP funds in FY 2022.

# Administrative Amendment:

Amend the Lisa Drive Connectivity Project (LDCP) Preliminary Engineering Phase (Dona Ana County) (MPO ID#E603A/CN E100290) to continue the multi-purpose path and environmental control feature which provides increased ADA accessibility adjacent to Lisa Drive to add \$7,801 of New Mexico TAP funds for a total of \$50,420 in FY 2020.

The Transportation Project Advisory Committee (TPAC) meeting and the Transportation Policy Board (TPB) meetings were used as open forums for the MPO public involvement process, and these project have no apparent adverse effects on air quality conformity. These meetings were advertised in local newspapers.
