- Amend the Horizon 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and the Horizon 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to program County of El Paso Statewide Transportation Alternative Set-Aside (TASA) project in Fiscal Year (FY) 2019, Off –Road Shared Used Path (SUP) along O.T. Smith Road that extends from Alameda Avenue to the I-10 Intersection, a distance of approximately 2.45 miles for \$2,143,913 under Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) Minute Order 115076 awarded on October 26, 2017.

### DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE TRANSPORTATION PROJECT ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

- a. University Avenue Pedestrian Enhancements Phase III (MPO ID# E108X-3) to use \$453,306 (80% federal / 20% local match) of Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) Set-Aside funding, and \$1,029,608 of local contribution for a total construction cost of \$1,482,914, in fiscal year (FY) 2018. <u>This project ranked highest in the TPB approved TAP project list (Sponsor UTEP).</u>
- b. TIWA Boulevard Preliminary Engineering (PE) (MPO ID #P512X-15A-PE) to use \$3,670,000 (80% federal / 20% local match) of Surface Transportation Program-Metropolitan Mobility (STP-MM) funding, and \$1,887,882 of local contribution for a total PE cost of \$5,557,882, in FY 2018. <u>This project is eligible under the MPO's STP-MM, PE Policy (Sponsor: City of Socorro).</u>
- c. Zaragoza Port of Entry (POE), Pan American / Winn Road (CSJ 0924-06-418/MPO ID# A524X-CAP-2) to use \$953,550 (80% federal / 20% local match) of STP-MM funding for a total construction cost of \$13,096,169, in FY 2018. <u>This project is eligible under the MPO's Year End Funds Policy (Sponsor: City of El Paso).</u>
- d. Central Business District (CBD) IV PE (MPO ID# R307D-PE-2) to use \$1,578,385 (80% federal / 20% local match) of STP-MM funding, in FY 2018. <u>This project is eligible under the MPO's Year End Funds Policy (Sponsor: City of El Paso).</u>
- e. Streetcar Operating Assistance-Phase 1 (CSJ 0924-06-552/MPO ID# T108X-1) to use \$2,174,640 (80% federal / 20% local match) of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding, in FY 2018. <u>This project is eligible under the MPO's Year End Funds</u> Policy (Sponsor: Sun Metro).
