RESOLUTION NO. MPO 2023 - 01

By the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Board

WHEREAS, the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization is the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization ("EPMPO") for the El Paso Urbanized Transportation Study Area; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Policy Board ("TPB") is the policy-making body responsible for establishing regional transportation planning policies for the El Paso Urbanized Transportation Study Area; and

WHEREAS, THE TPB Chairperson shall be the chief administrative officer of the TPB and will preside over each meeting of the TPB, and have execution authority on all MPO policy documents after TPB action; and

WHEREAS, a regular meeting of the TPB was held on January 20, 2023, at 9:30 a.m., at the Blue Flame Building, 304 Texas Avenue, El Paso, TX 79901, 17th Floor (Center for Community Engagement); and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Meeting and Agenda of the EPMPO TPB for the January 20, 2023 meeting was duly and properly posted pursuant to the requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the TPB was present and constituted a quorum; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the TPB quorum present at the meeting on January 20, 2023, considered, discussed, and voted in favor of approving and passing Agenda Items No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE TPB THAT: The following action items are consistent with the EPMPO's regional transportation planning policies for the El Paso Urbanized Transportation Study Area and are passed and approved by the TPB and become effective January 20, 2023:

- 1. Approved the minutes of the December 16, 2022 EPMPO TPB meeting.
- 2. Approved the nomination and election Judge Ricardo Samaniego as Chairperson of the Transportation Policy Board.
- 3. Approved the nomination and election of Mayor Oscar Leeser as Vice-Chairperson of the Transportation Policy Board.
- 4. Approved the appointment of 6 Members (Chair Judge Ricardo Samaniego, Vice-Chair Mayor Oscar Leeser, Tomas Trevino, Mayor Javier Perea, Representative Lina Ortega, Alderman Walter Miller) to EC pending 1 member.

- 5. Approved amendments to the EPMPO Bylaws and Procedures with alternates abiding with training requirements.
- 6. Approved the adoption of the State of New Mexico 2023 Safety Performance Measure (PM1) Targets.
- 7. Approved the adoption of the State of Texas 2023 Safety Performance Measure (PM1) Targets.
